Anatomy & Physiology (none are required)

A qualification in Anatomy & Physiology is not required to join the course, a pass from this course is sufficient to obtain UK insurance, is recognised by UK TMA and also, internationally by THAI.

But if you have a suitable A&P qualification then after passing this course you may also join the UK Complementary Therapists Association (CThA) professional register. If you intend to join CThA, but your A&P qualification is not to ITEC Level 3 then contact CThA on 0845 202 2941 to confirm that your A&P qualification meets their requirements for the Foundation Practitioner Diploma in Thai Massage.

Course pass requirements

- attend the 72 hours supervised training
- have a 1½ hour session from a professional Thai Massage practitioner (sessions will be available)
- pass the Case Study coursework
- pass the Theory and Practical exams
- submit a reflective journal.

You must attend all of the 72 supervised training hours to pass this course. If due to unforeseen circumstances you cannot attend a particular session then you may be able to attend an equivalent number of days training at the next course for a nominal fee, otherwise a tutorial may be possible, but this is also chargeable. These alternatives for making up time missed are only available until the end of the subsequent course.

Booking and payment

Perth Course

The cost of the Perth course is £895 including all materials, and your certification exams.

To book your place on the course send a deposit of £295 with this completed application form to TMO Ltd (see contact in the table on the previous page). The balance of the fees is payable in three further equal instalments: £200 is payable on the first day, another £200 instalment at the second training session, and the final £200 instalment at the third training session.
